

# Recombinant Human BTLA Protein, hFc-tagged, Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated

## SPECIFICATION

<b>Product Overview</b>	Alexa Fluor 647 conjugated recombinant human BTLA (Lys31-Ser150) protein was fused to human IgG1 Fc tag at C-terminus and expressed in human 293 cells (HEK293).

<b>Description</b>	B- and T-lymphocyte attenuator (BTLA) is also known as B- and T-lymphocyte-associated protein, CD antigen CD272. BTLA contains one Ig-like V-type (immunoglobulin-like) domain. As a lymphocyte inhibitory receptor, BTLA/CD272 inhibits lymphocytes during immune response. BTLA/CD272 can interact with tyrosine phosphatases PTPN6/SHP-1 and PTPN11/SHP-2, and interact with TNFRSF14/HVEM.
<b>Form</b>	Lyophilized
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	The protein has a calculated MW of 40.4 kDa. The protein migrates as 50-60 kDa under reducing (R) condition (SDS-PAGE) due to glycosylation.
<b>N-terminal Sequence Analysis</b>	Lys 31

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<b>Endotoxin</b>	< 1.0 EU/ µg by the LAL method.
<b>Purity</b>	> 92 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
<b>Characteristic</b>	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with Alexa Fluor 647 via amines Excitation = 650 nm Emission = 668 nm
<b>Storage</b>	For long term storage, the product should be stored at lyophilized state at -20 centigrade or lower. Please avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. This product is stable after storage at: -20 to -70 centigrade for 12 months in lyophilized state; -70 centigrade for 3 months under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
<b>Storage Buffer</b>	Lyophilized from 0.22 µm filtered solution in Tris with Glycine, Arginine and NaCl, pH7.5, 10% trehalose.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 µg/µL. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
<b>Conjugation</b>	Alexa Fluor 647
