MolecularMass	The recombinant human BTN1A1 consists of 242 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 27.20 kDa. It migrates as an approximately 36.09 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.

Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE. > 90 % as determined by SEC-HPLC.
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
