

## Recombinant Human CD274 Protein, His-tagged

<b>Product Overview</b>	Recombinant Homo sapiens CD274 Protein transcript variant 1 Ig-like V-type domain (NM_014143, 19-132aa), was expressed in human cells with His tag.

<b>ProteinLength</b>	19-132 aa
<b>Description</b>	<p>This gene encodes an immune inhibitory receptor ligand that is expressed by hematopoietic and non-hematopoietic cells, such as T cells and B cells and various types of tumor cells. The encoded protein is a type I transmembrane protein that has immunoglobulin V-like and C-like domains. Interaction of this ligand with its receptor inhibits T-cell activation and cytokine production. During infection or inflammation of normal tissue, this interaction is important for preventing autoimmunity by maintaining homeostasis of the immune response. In tumor microenvironments, this interaction provides an immune escape for tumor cells through cytotoxic T-cell inactivation. Expression of this gene in tumor cells is considered to be prognostic in many types of human malignancies, including colon cancer and renal cell carcinoma. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.</p>
<b>Form</b>	Purified protein formulated in a sterile solution of TBS buffer, pH7.346, without any preservatives.
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	26 kDa

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<b>Endotoxin</b>	Endotoxin level is < 0.1 ng/g of protein (<1EU /g)
<b>Purity</b>	>90% by SDS-PAGE gel and Coomassie Blue staining
<b>Applications</b>	Antigens, Western, ELISA and other in vitro binding or in vivo functional assays, and protein-protein interaction studies.

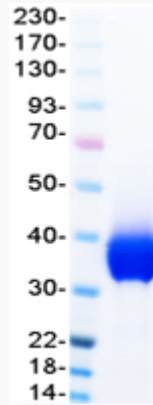
