Molecular Mass	The recombinant Rhesus Macaque CD79B Protein has a predicted molecular mass of 16.1kDa, it migrates with an apparent molecular mass of 20-30kDa under reducing conditions.
AA Sequence	Ala30-Asp161
Endotoxin	< 0.01 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	Greater than 95% as determined by reducing SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.25 mg/ml. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

Shipping In general, recombinant proteins are provided as lyophilized powder which are shipped at ambient temperature.
Bulk packages of recombinant proteins are provided as frozen liquid. They are shipped out with blue ice unless customers require otherwise.
