

## Recombinant Human CD86 protein, His & T7-tagged

### SPECIFICATION

<b>Product Overview</b>	Recombinant Human CD86 aa. (Gln46~Cys282 (Accession # P42081)) fused with N-terminal His & T7 tag was produced in E. coli cells.
<b>Species</b>	Human

<b>ProteinLength</b>	Gln46~Cys282
<b>Description</b>	This gene encodes a type I membrane protein that is a member of the immunoglobulin superfamily. This protein is expressed by antigen-presenting cells, and it is the ligand for two proteins at the cell surface of T cells, CD28 antigen and cytotoxic T-lymphocyte-associated protein 4. Binding of this protein with CD28 antigen is a costimulatory signal for activation of the T-cell. Binding of this protein with cytotoxic T-lymphocyte-associated protein 4 negatively regulates T-cell activation and diminishes the immune response. Alternative splicing results in several transcript variants encoding different isoforms.

<b>Characteristic</b>	The isoelectric point is 8.2.
<b>Applications</b>	SDS-PAGE; WB; ELISA; IP
<b>Stability</b>	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
<b>Storage</b>	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
<b>Storage buffer</b>	Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 5% trehalose, 0.01% sarcosyl
<b>Reconstitution</b>	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4

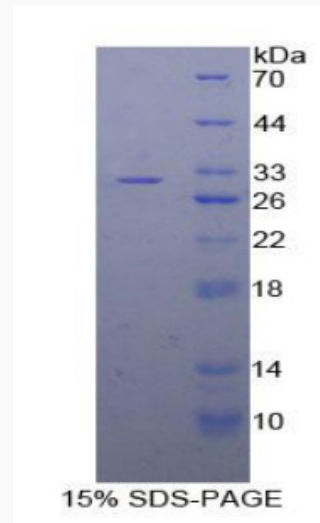
