Product Overview	Recombinant Human COL1A1 active fragments was metabolized and expressed by <i>Pichia pastoris</i> using synthetic biology technology. Sponge like solids are obtained by solid-liquid separation, ultrafiltration, chromatography, freeze-drying, and other processes from the fermentation broth. It has the characteristics of high purity, high activity, high stability, high homology and low immunogenicity.

Description	Collagen, type I, alpha 1, also known as COL1A1, is a human gene that encodes the major component of type I collagen, the fibrillar collagen found in most connective tissues, including cartilage. Collagen is a protein that strengthens and supports many tissues in the body, including cartilage, bone, tendon, skin and the white part of the eye (sclera). The COL1A1 gene produces a component of type I collagen, called the pro-alpha1(I) chain. This chain combines with another pro-alpha1(I) chain and also with a pro-alpha2(I) chain (produced by the COL1A2 gene) to make a molecule of type I procollagen. These triple-stranded, rope-like procollagen molecules must be processed by enzymes outside the cell. Once these molecules are processed, they arrange themselves into long, thin fibrils that cross-link to one another in the spaces around cells. The cross-links result in the formation of very strong mature type I collagen fibers.

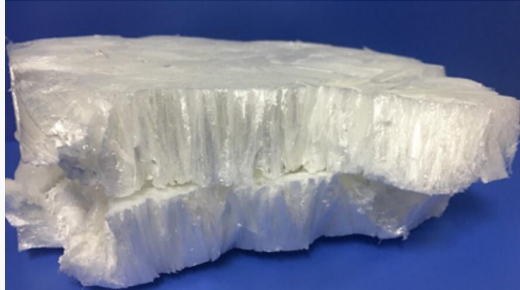
