Molecular Mass	The recombinant rat CD226/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 475 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 53.6 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 62-68 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing co

Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU/ µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE
Characteristic	Disulfide-linked homodimer Labeled with FITC via amines

Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5%-8% trehalose and mannitol are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
