### SPECIFICATION

<b>Product Overview</b>	Purified recombinant protein of mouse full-length ectodysplasin-A receptor (Edar), with C-terminal MYC/DDK tag, expressed in HEK293T cells.
<b>Species</b>	Mouse
<b>Source</b>	HEK293
<b>Description</b>	Receptor for EDA isoform TAA, but not for EDA isoform TA-2. May mediate the activation of NF-kappa-B and JNK. May promote caspase-independent cell death.
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	48.5 kDa
<b>Purity</b>	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
<b>Stability</b>	Stable for 12 months from the date of receipt of the product under proper storage and handling conditions. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Storage</b>	Store at -80 centigrade after receiving vials.
<b>Concentration</b>	>50 µg/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
<b>Storage Buffer</b>	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
