Molecular Mass The recombinant rat Erb2/Fc is a disulfide-linked homodimer. The reduced monomer comprises 638 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 70.6 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the rat Erb2 is approximately 95-105 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions due to glycosylation.

Stability	Samples are stable for up to 12 months from date of receipt at -70 centigrade.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -20 to -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage Buffer	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4
Reconstitution	It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution. Centrifuge the vial at 4 centigrade before opening to recover the entire contents.
