<b>Product Overview</b>	Recombinant Influenza A H15N2 (A/Australian shelduck/Western Australia/1756/1983) HA protein(Met1-Arg349)(ABB90704.1), fused with His tag, was expressed in HEK293.

<b>Form</b>	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Please contact us for any concerns or special requirements. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization. Please refer to the specific buffer information in the hard copy of CoA.
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	The recombinant HA1 subunit of Influenza A virus (A/Australian shelduck/ Western Australia/1756/1983(H15N2)) comprises 342 amino acids and has a predicted molecular mass of 37.6 kDa. The apparent molecular mass of the protein is approximately 51.6 kDa in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
<b>Endotoxin</b>	< 1.0 EU per µg of the protein as determined by the LAL method
<b>Purity</b>	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE

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**Storage**

Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C  
Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

**Reconstitution**

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.

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
