Product Overview	The extracellular domain of human CD278 [ICOS] (aa 21-139) is fused to the N-terminus of the Fc region of human IgG1.

Description	CD278, also called inducible costimulator (ICOS) or CRP1 (CD28-related protein-1), is a member of the growing CD28 family of immune costimulatory receptors. Other family members are CD28, CTLA-4 and PD-1. ICOS is expressed on most CD45RO+ cells. ICOS expression is upregulated within approximately 24-48 hours of activation on Th primed cells. B7-H2, a member of the B7 family of costimulatory ligands, has been identified as the ICOS ligand. The B7-H2/ICOS interaction appears to play roles in T cell dependent B cell activation and Th differentiation.
Form	Lyophilized from 0.2µm-filtered solution in PBS.
Purity	≥98% (SDS-PAGE)
Stability	Stable for at least 1 year after receipt when stored at -20°C. Working aliquots are stable for up to 3 months when stored at -20°C.
Storage	Short Term Storage: +4°C; Long Term Storage: -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
