### SPECIFICATION

<b>Product Overview</b>	The recombinant human RELT-Fc fusion is expressed as a 365 amino acid protein consisting of Ser26 - Gln162 region of RELT (UniProt accession #Q969Z4) and a C-terminal Fc from human IgG1, which exists as a dimer under non-reducing conditions.

<b>Form</b>	Supplied at 0.5 mg/ml in sterile PBS pH7.4 (carrier & preservative free). The purified recombinant protein was labeled with Biotin (3-5 Biotin per molecule).
<b>Molecular Mass</b>	Calculated molecular mass (kDa): 40; Estimated by SDS-PAGE under reducing condition (kDa): 45-55
<b>Endotoxin</b>	<0.1 eu per 1 µg of purified recombinant protein determined by the lal">
<b>Purity</b>	>95% judged by SDS-PAGE under reducing condition
<b>Storage</b>	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, centrifuge the product briefly before opening the vial. It is recommended to store small aliquots at the temperature below -20°C for long-term storage and the product is stable for 3 months. The undiluted protein can be stored at 4°C for no more than 2 weeks. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw
