Description	This gene encodes a type I integral membrane protein found only in the rough endoplasmic reticulum. The encoded protein is part of an N-oligosaccharyl transferase complex that links high mannose oligosaccharides to asparagine residues found in the Asn-X-Ser/Thr consensus motif of nascent polypeptide chains. This protein forms part of the regulatory subunit of the 26S proteasome and may mediate binding of ubiquitin-like domains to this proteasome.

Molecular Mass	18kDa as determined by SDS-PAGE reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	<1.0EU per 1g (determined by the LAL method)

Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 6.2.

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage buffer	Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH 7.4, containing 5% sucrose.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.
