Form	CD43 at 100g/ml in 50mM Tris-Acetate, pH7.5, 1mM EDTA and 20% Glycerol.
Physical Appearance	Sterile Filtered clear solution.
Storage	Store vial at -20°C to -80°C. When stored at the recommended temperature, this protein is stable for 12 months. Please prevent freeze-thaw cycles.
