SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant SARS-CoV-2 Spike S1 (YP_009724390.1, with mutations T19R, G142D, L452R, E484Q, D614G, P681R) (Met1-Arg685) was expressed in HEK293 with a polyhistidine tag at the C-terminus. The mutations were identified in the SARS-CoV-2 variant (known as variant B.1.617.3) which emerged in the India.

Form	Lyophilized from sterile PBS, pH 7.4. Normally 5 % - 8 % trehalose, mannitol and 0.01% Tween80 are added as protectants before lyophilization.
Molecular Mass	The recombinant SARS-CoV-2 Spike S1 consists of 681 amino acids and predicts a molecular mass of 76.62 kDa. As a result of glycosylation, it migrates as an approximately 90.30 kDa band in SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	< 1.0 EU per µg protein as determined by the LAL method.
Purity	> 90 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Storage	Samples are stable for up to twelve months from date of receipt at -20°C to -80°C. Store it under sterile conditions at -20°C to -80°C. It is recommended that the protein

be aliquoted for optimal storage. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

It is recommended that sterile water be added to the vial to prepare a stock solution of 0.2 ug/ul. Centrifuge the vial at 4°C before opening to recover the entire contents.
