Form	The purified protein was lyophilized from sterile phosphate-buffered saline (PBS: 58 mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17 mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68 mM NaCl, pH 7.4). Prior to lyophilization, 5% (w/v) trehalose and 5% (w/v) mannitol were incorporated as cryoprotective excipients. The protein was eluted with a buffer containing 300 mM imidazole.

Purity	85%, by SDS-PAGE with Coomassie Brilliant Blue staining.
Storage	Store at 2-8°C for 1-2 weeks. Aliquot and store at -20°C to -80°C for up to 3 months, reconstitution with sterile water and addition of an equal volume of glycerol. Avoid

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repeat freeze-thaw cycles.

Reconstitution

Dissolve the product in 200 µl sterile water to achieve a working concentration of 0.25 g/µl. If experimental compatibility allows, mix the aqueous solution with an equal volume of glycerol (1:1 ratio) after initial reconstitution.
