Purity	95 % as determined by SDS-PAGE.
Notes	Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
Storage	Store it under sterile conditions at -70 centigrade. It is recommended that the protein be aliquoted into smaller quantities and be used as soon as possible.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in 20 mM Tris, 150 mM NaCl (pH 8.0) to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

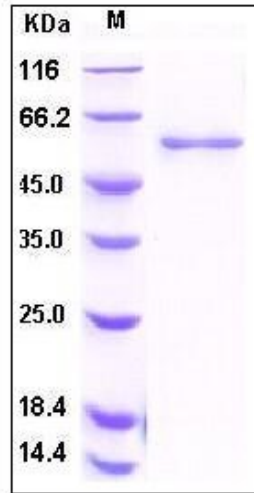
