

## Recombinant Human VNN1 Protein, His-tagged

### SPECIFICATION

<b>Product Overview</b>	Recombinant Human VNN1 Protein (Gln22-Gly491) with N-His tag was expressed in E. coli.
<b>Species</b>	Human

<b>ProteinLength</b>	Gln22-Gly491
<b>Description</b>	<p>This gene encodes a member of the vanin family of proteins, which share extensive sequence similarity with each other, and also with biotinidase. The family includes secreted and membrane-associated proteins, a few of which have been reported to participate in hematopoietic cell trafficking. No biotinidase activity has been demonstrated for any of the vanin proteins, however, they possess pantetheinase activity, which may play a role in oxidative-stress response. This protein, like its mouse homolog, is likely a GPI-anchored cell surface molecule. The mouse protein is expressed by the perivascular thymic stromal cells and regulates migration of T-cell progenitors to the thymus. This gene lies in close proximity to, and in the same transcriptional orientation as, two other vanin genes on chromosome 6q23-q24.</p>

<b>Applications</b>	Positive Control; Immunogen; SDS-PAGE; WB.
<b>Stability</b>	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37 centigrade for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
<b>Storage</b>	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8 centigrade for one month. Aliquot and store at -80 centigrade for 12 months.
<b>Storage Buffer</b>	PBS, pH7.4, containing 0.01% SKL, 1 mM DTT, 5% Trehalose and Proclin300.
<b>Reconstitution</b>	Reconstitute in sterile water to a concentration of 0.1-1.0 mg/mL. Do not vortex.

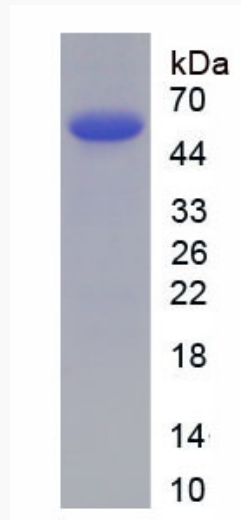
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
