Product Overview	Recombinant Human GLS2 fused with His tag at N-terminal was expressed in E. coli.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a mitochondrial phosphate-activated glutaminase that catalyzes the hydrolysis of glutamine to stoichiometric amounts of glutamate and ammonia. Originally thought to be liver-specific, this protein has been found in other tissues as well. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants that encode different isoforms.
Form	25mM Tris, pH8.0, 150 mM NaCl, 10% glycerol, 1 % Sarkosyl.
Molecular Mass	66.1 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Storage	Store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
