Product Overview	Recombinant Human ABO fused with MYC/DDK tag at C-terminal was expressed in HEK293.

Description	This protein is the basis of the ABO blood group system. The histo-blood group ABO involves three carbohydrate antigens: A, B, and H. A, B, and AB individuals express a glycosyltransferase activity that converts the H antigen to the A antigen (by addition of UDP-GalNAc) or to the B antigen (by addition of UDP-Gal), whereas O individuals lack such activity.
Form	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
Molecular Mass	40.8 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
