Description	This gene encodes an E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase that plays a role in neural-cell differentiation. Overexpression of this gene causes neurite-like elongation. The encoded protein contains both a zinc finger and a RING finger motif and is localized in the endosome/lysosome compartment, indicating that it may be involved in ubiquitin-mediated protein modification, and in synaptic vesicle membranes in neurons.
Form	Supplied as a 0.2 µ filtered solution of 20mM Tris, 0.15M NaCl, 1mM EDTA, 10%glycerol, pH 8.0
