Product Overview	Recombinant Human MINPP1, transcript variant 1, fused with DDK tag at C-terminal was expressed in Sf9 cells.

Description	This gene encodes multiple inositol polyphosphate phosphatase; an enzyme that removes 3-phosphate from inositol phosphate substrates. It is the only enzyme known to hydrolyze inositol pentakisphosphate and inositol hexakisphosphate. This enzyme also converts 2,3 bisphosphoglycerate (2,3-BPG) to 2-phosphoglycerate; an activity formerly thought to be exclusive to 2,3-BPG synthase/2-phosphatase (BPGM) in the Rapoport-Luebering shunt of the glycolytic pathway.
Form	50mM Tris-HCl, pH8.0, 100mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
Molecular Mass	54.9 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
