Product Overview	Recombinant Human GMEB1 fused with His tag at C-terminal was expressed in Sf9 cells.
Species	Human
Source	Sf9 Cells
Description	This gene encodes a member of KDWK gene family which associates with GMEB2 protein. The GMEB1-GMEB2 complex is essential for parvovirus DNA replication. Studies in rat for a similar gene suggest that this gene's role is to modulate the transactivation of the glucocorticoid receptor when it is bound to glucocorticoid response elements. Three alternative spliced transcript variants encoding different isoforms exist.
Form	50mM Tris-HCl pH8.0, 150mM NaCl, 20% glycerol. Store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
