Description	The Tick-borne encephalitis virus (TBEV) is a Flavivirus which is transmitted to humans through a bite from an infected tick. Tick-borne encephalitis (TBE) is endemic in Europe and Asia with an average of 8,500 cases per year in Europe. TBE infected patients typically present with influenza-like symptoms and the disease is neuroinvasive often manifesting as meningitis, encephalitis or meningoencephalitis. Long-lasting or permanent neuropsychiatric sequelae are reported in 10 to 20% of patients.
Purity	>95% pure by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store at 2-8 centigrade for short term, or frozen at -20 centigrade to -80 centigrade for long term.
Concentration	0.5mg/ml
