Description	This gene encodes a regulator of the cell division cycle 7 homolog (<i>S. cerevisiae</i>) protein, a serine-threonine kinase which links cell cycle regulation to genome duplication. This protein localizes to the nucleus and, in complex with the cell division cycle 7 homolog (<i>S. cerevisiae</i>) protein, may facilitate M phase progression. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants. [provided by RefSeq, Sep 2010].
