Product Overview	Recombinant Human PTEN fused with His tag at N-terminal was expressed in Sf9 cells.

Source	Sf9 Cells
Description	Isoform alpha: Functional kinase, like isoform 1 it antagonizes the PI3K-AKT/PKB signaling pathway. Plays a role in mitochondrial energetic metabolism by promoting COX activity and ATP production, via collaboration with isoform 1 in increasing protein levels of PINK1.
Form	50mM Tris-HCl pH8.0, 150mM NaCl, 20% glycerol. Store at -80 centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.
Molecular Mass	47 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
