Product Overview	Recombinant Human A2M aa. (Ser616~Val856 (Accession # P01023)) fused with N-terminal His tag was produced in E. coli cells.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a protease inhibitor and cytokine transporter. It uses a bait-and-trap mechanism to inhibit a broad spectrum of proteases, including trypsin, thrombin and collagenase. It can also inhibit inflammatory cytokines, and it thus disrupts inflammatory cascades. Mutations in this gene are a cause of alpha-2-macroglobulin deficiency. This gene is implicated in Alzheimer's disease (AD) due to its ability to mediate the clearance and degradation of A-beta, the major component of beta-amyloid deposits. A related pseudogene, which is also located on the p arm of chromosome 12, has been identified.

Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 5.7.
Applications	SDS-PAGE; WB; ELISA; IP.
Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. The loss rate is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage buffer	Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH 7.4, containing 5% sucrose, 0.01% sarcosyl.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.

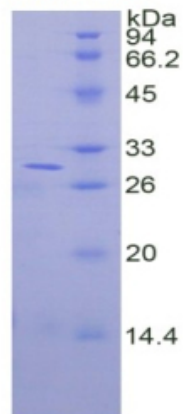
