Description	This gene encodes a component of a ubiquitination complex. The encoded protein is involved in the ubiquitination and degradation of hypoxia-inducible-factor (HIF), which is a transcription factor that plays a central role in the regulation of gene expression by oxygen. In addition to oxygen-related gene expression, this protein plays a role in many other cellular processes including cilia formation, cytokine signaling, regulation of senescence, and formation of the extracellular matrix. Variants of this gene are associated with von Hippel-Lindau syndrome, pheochromocytoma, erythrocytosis, renal cell carcinoma, and cerebellar hemangioblastoma.
Form	The protein is in 20mM Tris-HCl pH7.9, 100mM NaCl, 0.2mM EDTA, 1mM DTT and 20% glycerol.

Storage	Stored at -70 centigrade before use. Avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles.
Unit Definition	1 unit equals 1 nanogram of purified protein. 30-100 units (ng) are required for an in vitro transcription assay and protein-protein interaction assay.
