Description	Prion Protein (PrP) is an abundant cellular protein in mammalian neural tissue. It is associated with mammalian prion diseases, e.g. transmissible spongiforme encephalopathies that include human Creutzfeld-Jakob disease, bovine spongiforme encephalopathy, sheep scrapie, cervid's chronic wasting disease and various rodent prion diseases. In the disease process, PrP undergoes protein aggregation into disease specific PrPSc.
Form	Finally dialysed in pure water, shock frozen in liquid nitrogen at a protein concentration of 0.25 mg/ml.
