Description	ACPP is a phosphomonoesterase, an enzyme that cleaves phosphate groups from other molecules during digestion. Different organs produce different forms of ACPP. The serum levels of which can be used as a diagnostic for disease in the corresponding organs. This form, human ACPP, is specific to human prostate. ACPP are stored in lysosomes and function upon fusion with endosomes. The acidic environment of the endosome is required for function.

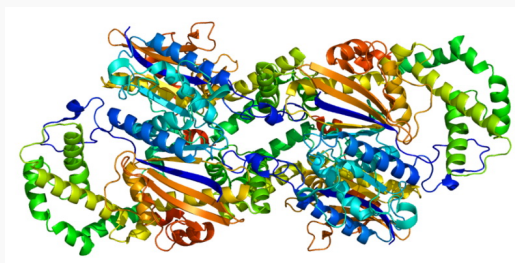
