Product Overview	Recombinant Human DDO, transcript variant 1, fused with MYC/DDK tag at C-terminal was expressed in HEK293.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a peroxisomal flavoprotein that catalyzes the oxidative deamination of D-aspartate and N-methyl D-aspartate. Flavin adenine dinucleotide or 6-hydroxyflavin adenine dinucleotide can serve as the cofactor in this reaction. Two transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
