Description	This gene encodes the enzyme responsible for hydrolysis of both HIBYL-CoA and beta-hydroxypropionyl-CoA. Mutations in this gene have been associated with 3-hydroxyisobutyryl-CoA hydrolase deficiency. Alternative splicing results in multiple transcript variants.
Form	25 mM Tris.HCl, pH 7.3, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol.
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
