Product Overview	Recombinant Human TGM1 aa. (Ala496~Arg760 (Accession # P22735)) fused with N-terminal His & GST tag was produced in E. coli cells.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a membrane protein that catalyzes the addition of an alkyl group from an alkylamine to a glutamine residue of a protein, forming an alkylglutamine in the protein. This protein alkylation leads to crosslinking of proteins and catenation of polyamines to proteins. This gene contains either one or two copies of a 22 nt repeat unit in its 3' UTR. Mutations in this gene have been associated with autosomal recessive lamellar ichthyosis (LI) and nonbullous congenital ichthyosiform erythroderma (NCIE).

Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 6.4.
Applications	SDS-PAGE; WB; ELISA; IP.
Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate of the target protein. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. (Referring from China Biological Products Standard, which was calculated by the Arrhenius equation.) The loss of this protein is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 5% sucrose, 0.01% sarcosyl.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.

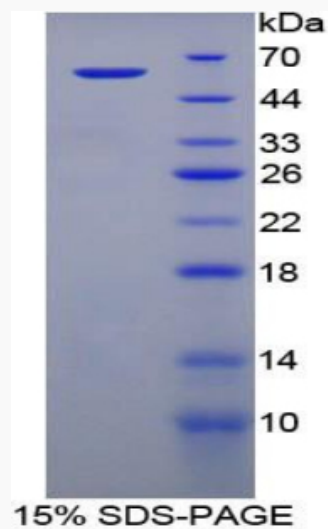
