Description	The protein encodedby this gene is a member of the pexin family. Vitronectin is an abundantglycoprotein found in serum and the extracellular matrix and promotes celladhesion and spreading, inhibits the membrane-damaging effect of the terminalcytolytic complement pathway, and binds to several serpin serine protease inhibitors.
Form	Liquid in 0.05 Msodium phosphate + 0.1 M NaCl, pH 7.4.
Molecular Weight	75.0 kDa monomer
Concentration	5.0 mg/ml
Storage	Store in workingaliquots at -80°C. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
