Description	Thyroid Peroxidase(TPO) is a membrane-bound glycoprotein. TPO acts as an enzyme and plays a central role in thyroid gland function. It functions in the iodination of tyrosine residues in thyroglobulin and phenoxy-ester formation between pairs of iodinated tyrosines to generate the thyroid hormones, Thyroxine and Triiodothyronine. Mutations in TPO are associated with several disorders of thyroid hormoneogenesis, including congenital hypothyroidism, congenital goiter, and thyroid hormone organification defect IIA.
Form	Liquid in 20 mM Tris+ 50 mM KCl, pH 7.5 without preservative
Concentration	1.0 mg/mL
Purity	>98% by SDS-PAGE
Storage	Store in working aliquots at -20°C. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
