Description	Serpinc1 is a small protein that inactivates several enzymes of the Coagulation Cascade. Serpinc1 is a glycoprotein produced by the liver and consists of 432aa. It contains three disulfide bonds and a total of four possible glycosylation sites. AT3 includes two functional domains: the heparin binding-domain at the N-terminus of the mature protein, and the reactive site domain at the C-terminus. The inhibitory activity is enhanced by the presence of heparin.
Form	Frozen Liquid in 0.05 M Sodium Phosphate + 0.1 M NaCl + 1 mM EDTA pH 7.4.
Purity	Several chromatographic steps.
Storage	Store at -70°C.
Concentration	5.0 mg/mL.
