Product Overview	Recombinant Human KREMEN1 aa. (Lys157~Gly390 (Accession # Q96MU8)) fused with N-terminal His & T7 tag was produced in E. coli cells.

Description	This gene encodes a high-affinity dickkopf homolog 1 (DKK1) transmembrane receptor that functionally cooperates with DKK1 to block wntless (WNT)/beta-catenin signaling. The encoded protein is a component of a membrane complex that modulates canonical WNT signaling through lipoprotein receptor-related protein 6 (LRP6). It contains extracellular kringle, WSC, and CUB domains. Alternatively spliced transcript variants encoding distinct isoforms have been observed for this gene.
Form	Freeze-dried powder
Molecular Mass	Predicted Molecular Mass: 29.3kDa.
Endotoxin	<1.0EU per 1ug (determined by the LAL method)
Purity	>95%

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Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 5.6.
Applications	SDS-PAGE; WB; ELISA; IP.
Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate of the target protein. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. (Referring from China Biological Products Standard, which was calculated by the Arrhenius equation.) The loss of this protein is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	Supplied as lyophilized form in PBS, pH7.4, containing 5% trehalose, 0.01% sarcosyl.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.

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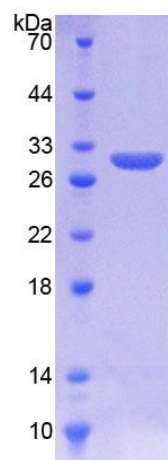
