Product Overview	Recombinant Human RNASE4 aa. (Asp30~Gly147 (Accession # P34096)) fused with N-terminal His tag was produced in E. coli cells.

Description	The protein encoded by this gene belongs to the pancreatic ribonuclease family. It plays an important role in mRNA cleavage and has marked specificity towards the 3' side of uridine nucleotides. Alternative splicing results in four transcript variants encoding the same protein. This gene and the gene that encodes angiogenin share promoters and 5' exons. Each gene splices to a unique downstream exon that contains its complete coding region.

Molecular Mass	15 kDa as determined by SDS-PAGE reducing conditions.
Endotoxin	<1.0EU per 1ug (determined by the LAL method)
Purity	>95%
Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 9.

Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate of the target protein. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. (Referring from China Biological Products Standard, which was calculated by the Arrhenius equation.) The loss of this protein is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage Buffer	Supplied as liquid form in Phosphate buffered saline(PBS), pH 7.4.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile PBS, pH7.2-pH7.4.
