Description	EPHB3 is a protein that in humans is encoded by theEPHB3 gene. Ephrin receptors and their ligands,the ephrins, mediate numerous developmental processes, particularly in thenervous system. Based on their structures and sequence relationships, ephrinsare divided into the ephrin-A (EFNA) class, which are anchored to themembrane by a glycosylphosphatidylinositol linkage, and the ephrin-B (EFNB)class, which are transmembrane proteins.
Form	Liquid in 50 mMTris, pH 7.5 + 150 mM NaCl + 0.5 mM EDTA + 0.02% Triton X-100 + 2 mM DTT +50% glycerol.
