Product Overview	Recombinant Human Alpha-internexin produced in <i>E.coli</i> is a 66kDa, type IV intermediate filament protein that is expressed in neurons during development of the peripheral and central nervous systems, as well as in a few neurons of the adult central nervous system.

Source	E.coli
Description	Alpha-internexin, is a Class IV intermediate filament approximately 66 KDa. The protein was originally purified from rat optic nerve and spinal cord. The protein copurifies with other neurofilament subunits, as it was originally discovered, however in some mature neurons it can be the only neurofilament expressed. The protein is present in developing neuroblasts and in the Central Nervous System of adults. The protein is a major component of the intermediate filament network in small interneurons and cerebellar granule cells, where it is present in the parallel fibers.
Presentation	100µg purified human α-Internexin protein at 0.1mg/ml in 50mM Tris-Acetate, pH7.5, 1mM EDTA and 20% glycerol.

Characterization	On SDS-PAGE comassie blue stained gel, the purified recombinant PTEN shows a band at 45 kDa antibody reactive.
