Product Overview	Recombinant humanHMBS protein, fused to His-tag at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli andpurified by using conventional chromatography techniques.

Description	Porphobilinogendeaminase, also known as HMBS, is a member of the hydroxymethylbilanesynthase superfamily. It is a cytoplasmic enzyme found in the heme synthesispathway. Deficiency of HMBS causes errors in pyrrole metabolism which in turnleads to an inherited autosomal disorder called acute intermittent porphyria(AIP) which is characterized by acute attacks of neurological dysfunctionswith hypertension, tachycardia, peripheral neurologic disturbances, abdominalpain and excessive amounts of aminolevulinic acid and porphobilinogen in theurine.
Form	Liquid. In 20mMTris-HCl buffer (pH 8.0) containing 1mM DTT, 10% glycerol, 0.1M NaCl.
