Product Overview	Recombinant Mouse Nr0b1 aa. (Met1~Ala227 (Accession # Q61066) fused with N-terminal His & T7 tag was produced in E. coli cells.

Description	This gene encodes an orphan nuclear receptor protein that plays a key role in differentiation of the gonads. This protein regulates steroidogenic factor 1 (Sf-1) in a dose-dependent manner, sometimes functioning as a repressor of SF-1 target genes, and sometimes functioning as a co-activator. Overexpression of this gene can cause feminization of the XY male gonads. This gene is also involved in the maintenance of embryonic stem cell pluripotency. Mutations in the related gene in human cause congenital adrenal hypoplasia and hypogonadotropic hypogonadism.

Characteristic	The isoelectric point is 7.0.
Applications	SDS-PAGE; WB; ELISA; IP.
Stability	The thermal stability is described by the loss rate of the target protein. The loss rate was determined by accelerated thermal degradation test, that is, incubate the protein at 37°C for 48h, and no obvious degradation and precipitation were observed. (Referring from China Biological Products Standard, which was calculated by the Arrhenius equation.) The loss of this protein is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.
Storage	Avoid repeated freeze/thaw cycles. Store at 2-8°C for one month. Aliquot and store at -80°C for 12 months.
Storage buffer	Supplied as lyophilized form in 20mM Tris, 150mM NaCl, pH8.0, containing 1mM EDTA, 1mM DTT, 0.01% sarcosyl, 5% trehalose, and preservative.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute in sterile ddH ₂ O.

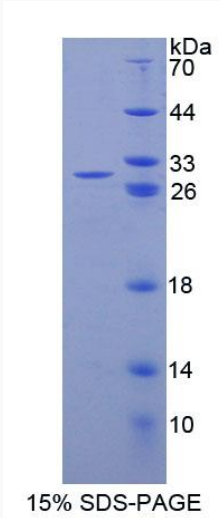
