The loss of this protein is less than 5% within the expiration date under appropriate storage condition.

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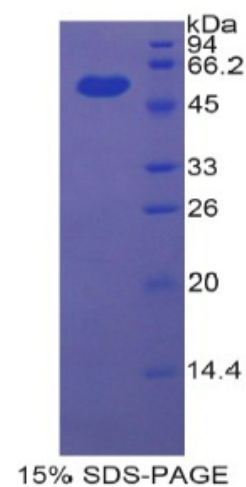
