Product Overview	Recombinant mouse Dkk1 protein was expressed in Chinese Hamster Ovary cell line, CHO-derived. Ser30-His272.

Description	Dkk1 is the founding member of the Dickkopf family of proteins that includes Dkk-1, -2, -3, -4, and a related protein, Soggy. Dkk proteins are secreted proteins that contain two conserved cysteine-rich domains separated by a linker region. Each domain contains ten cysteine residues. Mature mouse Dkk1 is a 40 kDa glycosylated protein that shares 86%, 96%, 83% and 82% amino acid (aa) sequence identity with human, rat, rabbit and bovine Dkk1, respectively.
Form	Lyophilized from a 0.2 µm filtered solution in PBS with BSA as a carrier protein.
N-terminal Sequence	Ser30 & Thr32
Molecular Weight	26.1 kDa
Activity	Measured by its ability to inhibit Wnt-3a-induced alkaline phosphatase production by MC3T3-E1 mouse osteoblastic cells. The ND50 for this effect is typically 0.02-0.1

Endotoxin Level	<1.0 EU per 1 µg of the protein by the LAL method.
Purity	>95%, by SDS-PAGE under reducing conditions and visualized by silver stain.
Reconstitution	Reconstitute at 100 µg/mL in sterile PBS that containing at least 0.1% human or bovine serum albumin.
Storage	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 3 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
