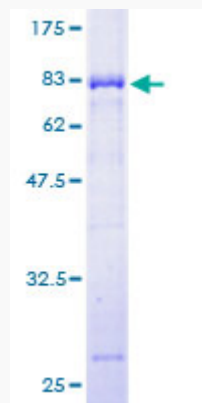
Notes	Best use within three months from the date of receipt of this protein.
