Description	STAP1, also known assignal-transducing adaptor protein 1, appears to functions as a dockingprotein acting downstream of Tec tyrosine kinase in B cell antigen receptorsignaling. The protein is directly phosphorylated by Tec in vitro where itparticipates in a positive feedback loop, increasing Tec activity
