Product Overview	Recombinant Human TRMT12 protein, fused to His-tagged at N-terminus, was expressed in E. coli.

Description	Wybutosine (yW) is a hypermodified guanosine at the 3-prime position adjacent to the anticodon of phenylalanine tRNA that stabilizes codon-anticodon interactions during decoding on the ribosome. TRMT12 is the human homolog of a yeast gene essential for yW synthesis (Noma and Suzuki, 2006).
Form	25 mM Tris, pH 8.0, 150 mM NaCl, 10% glycerol, 1% Sarkosyl. Store at -80 Centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.
Molecular Mass	50.2 kDa
Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
