SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant Human SYNC protein, fused to DDK-tagged at C-terminus, was expressed in Insect cells.
Species	Human
Source	Insect Cells
Description	This gene encodes a member of the intermediate filament family which contains an N-terminal head domain, followed by a central coiled-coil region and a short C-terminal tail. The protein is highly expressed in skeletal and cardiac muscle. The protein links the dystrophin associated protein complex (DAPC) to desmin filaments in muscle and may have a structural role in striated muscle. Multiple transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene.
Form	50 mM Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 100 mM glycine, 10% glycerol. Store at -80 Centigrade. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. Stable for at least 3 months from receipt of products under proper storage and handling conditions.

Purity	> 80% as determined by SDS-PAGE and Coomassie blue staining
Concentration	>50 ug/mL as determined by microplate BCA method
