SPECIFICATION

Product Overview	Recombinant Human ALDH1B1 protein was expressed as gst-tagged fusion protein by E. coli and purified by GSH-sepharose. The purified protein was resolved in 1M PBS (58mM Na ₂ HPO ₄ , 17mM NaH ₂ PO ₄ , 68mM NaCl, pH8.) added with 100mM GSH and 1% TritonX-100, 15% glycerol.

Description	ALDH1B1 belongs to the aldehyde dehydrogenases family of proteins. Aldehyde dehydrogenase is the second enzyme of the major oxidative pathway of alcohol metabolism. ALDH1B1 does not contain introns in the coding sequence. The variation of this locus may affect the development of alcohol-related problems.

Storage	The protein is stored in PBS buffer at -20°C. Repeated freeze-thaw cycles should be avoided.
