Product Overview	Recombinant human SMAD7 protein, fused to MYC/DDK-tagged at C-terminus, was expressed in HEK293

Description	The protein encoded by this gene is a nuclear protein that binds the E3 ubiquitin ligase SMURF2. Upon binding, this complex translocates to the cytoplasm, where it interacts with TGF-beta receptor type-1 (TGFB1), leading to the degradation of both the encoded protein and TGFB1. Expression of this gene is induced by TGFB1. Variations in this gene are a cause of susceptibility to colorectal cancer type 3 (CRC3). Several transcript variants encoding different isoforms have been found for this gene. [provided by RefSeq, Jun 2010].
